For those who are not familiar with this event, here is a brief explanation of Tag Day. Each parent driver is assigned a team of four students and a route of streets within the South Euclid – Lyndhurst School District. Each team of students is given a stack of Tags, which are schedules of Brush Band performances, and two milk or juice jugs. The student teams go door to door on their routes, explain the performance dates to the residents and ask for donations to help cover instrument and uniform costs. They will also invite the residents to the Band Spectacular and other Band events.

Tag Day has been an annual Brush Band event for many years and is very well received by the community. Many band/parent alumni still live in the area and are very supportive.

Students will sign up in groups of four. Each group is matched up with a parent driver that will stay with the students while they go door to door “tagging” and asking for donations.
