Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm.

Minutes (Joan Farmer): Minutes from the June and August meetings were approved.

Treasurer's Report (Michael Curran): Check book balance is \$120,352.91 and total operating funds are \$79,318.06. Report filed for audit.

Tag Day (Larry Arth): Tag Day brought in a record \$8600. Overall they were pleased with the outcome, but somewhat disappointed with student participation. Boosters may have an opportunity to participate in the mattress fundraiser next year.

Director (Kaylee Flynt): Performances so far have been very good and she expressed her thanks to the chaperones. This Friday (Sept 9) is the first home game; report time is 5:45 but there may be an earlier rehearsal to work on pre-game. Sept 11 is Lyndhurst Home Days parade. Report time is 12:45 and students should be in full uniform.

President (David Frey): Still exploring options to achieve more parent involvement. It was suggested that the Memorial Band be invited to perform at a home game, getting more parents to a game. That option will be discussed with Barry Hartz. Would also like to consider reviving the Band Boosters newsletter and distributing same via email and posting it on the website.

Uniforms (Elizabeth Heston): All students are outfitted though some uniforms are in poor condition. Some students still need to hem their pants. There are enough raincoats.

Website (Alex Heston): There were 685 visits to the website in August and content is up to date.

Chaperones (David Frey for Scott Karn): Scott is working on filling chaperone slots. Anyone interested in helping should contact him.

Fundraising (David Frey for Ann Brizee): Fabric for stadium seats is on back order so seats will not be ready until the end of September. She ordered 30 and 26 have been sold so far.

New Business:

It was suggested that Kaylee hold an 8th grade parent/student meeting at Memorial in January to discuss Brush Band participation and expectations.
